This is a classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc which is consistently produced in a fuller, riper, softer style that develops well. Clean, fresh and tropical, with fruit from several vineyards situated throughout Marlborough.

Screams out for seafood (think fresh oysters)!

Recommended Cellaring:

Best enjoyed while young.

Production Notes:

After harvest the grapes were quickly crushed and pressed into stainless steel tanks where the juice was fermented at controlled cool temperatures to capture the intense varietal flavours. After extensive tasting trials by the winemakers, the wine was blended, finished and bottled.

Alcohol: 13.0% TA: 7.4g/l pH: 3.3

Residual Sugar: 3.6g/l

Tasting Notes:

Softly perfumed with broom and tropical notes. Spicy. Well fruited entry and mid-palate, focused but lush. Long mineral spice finish.
